Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

Located in the breathtaking Jasper National Park in the Canadian Rocky Mountains, Marmot Basin is a ski and snowboard destination that inspires lasting memories.

Only 20 minutes from the town of Jasper, Marmot Basin offers 3,000 vertical feet (914m) of superb skiing and snowboarding on 1,720 acres of varied terrain. Large, snow filled bowls are paradise for powder skiers and snowboarders. For those who enjoy cruising, the state-of-the-art grooming fleet keeps the tree-lined trails groomed to perfection. Those who have already discovered Marmot Basin come back for the relaxed and friendly atmosphere, the superb variety of terrain, the first-class service and the spectacular Rocky Mountain scenery.

Jasper's newest hotel, the Crimson, is located at the edge of town within the heart of Jasper National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The park's shimmering glaciers, abundant wildlife, crystal-clear lakes, thundering waterfalls, deep canyons and evergreen forest are surrounded by towering mountains. A wealth of winter activities are available including Nordic skiing, snowshoeing, skating, dog sledding, ice climbing, Columbia Ice Fields, Maligne Canyon.

Accommodation

Located at the edge of downtown, The Crimson Jasper Hotel is Jasper's newest hotel. Standard Hotel Room. 7 nights, 2 Queen beds. Based upon double occupancy. In-room safe, fridge, microwave, free Wi-fi, indoor pool, hot tub.

- Land Only: Deduct \$550. The transfer bus will not wait for passengers who are arranging their own air travel. No discount will be given for missed transfers and those passengers must make their own arrangements to get to the resort.

Deviation charges: Any person deviating from the group itinerary will be charged \$90 CAD plus tax and any additional charges imposed by the suppliers and airlines. Deviations are on a request basis. Members must abide by the prearranged transfer dates and times or arrange their own transfers at their own cost.

Marmot Basin is known for tremendous variety with 91 marked trails. The runs are split evenly between easy, intermediate and advanced, making this an ideal destination for skiers and snowboarders of all abilities. With no waiting in lift lines, you have lots of room to breathe and even more time on the slopes. After an exhilarating day on the slopes, the town of Jasper offers everything a visitor might want. Jasper Crimson Hotel

The Crimson was inspired by true Canadian colours: Jasper's sunsets and fall foliage, our Canadian flag and the uniform of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. This 99 room hotel features spacious guestrooms, with two queen beds, free Wi-Fi, fridge, microwave and in-room safe. The hotel also features an indoor pool and hot tub. It is an easy one block walk to downtown shops and restaurants. Hot breakfast is included for HPSC quests.

Passport / Travel Documents

Canadian Citizens: Travelling within Canada – PHOTO ID is a requirement to board all aircraft.

Note: Members are solely responsible to ensure that their travel documents are complete, valid and in order.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Policies are set by the Tour Operators, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.

- Deposits (\$600) and Insurance Premium are non-refundable.
- On or after December 12 until departure, 100% non-refundable.
- Single Supplement cost has to be covered.

Optional Travel Insurance

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is available to protect non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. All Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person, contact Tour Operator in advance for a quote. To get the proper quote you must specify your name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost.

Insurance is non-refundable from date of issuance. Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above. Passengers must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above dates.

Tickets are 100% non-refundable once issued. Name changes and deviations are not permitted once ticketed. Individuals must ensure that all names are spelled correctly and match their personal identification on their passport. The Tour Operator and Airline will not be held liable for delays or cancellations caused by strikes, labour disputes, government actions, weather or any cause beyond the Tour Operator's or Airline's control. The Airline reserves the right to change equipment or schedules. The customer hereby releases and waives any claims against the Airline and Tour Operator regarding cancellation or schedule changes.
