Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

Aspen lives up to its winter reputation! Four ski mountains make up the terrain for the world-renowned Aspen Snowmass resort. **Aspen Mountain**, locally referred to as Ajax, rises up directly from downtown: you can ski down the same runs that have hosted World Cup finals, ride through gladed powder stashes, or put together one quadburning top-to-bottom after another. Aspen Mountain has 103kms of trails - 48% Intermediate, 26% Advanced, 26% Expert (no beginner runs here). Aspen Highlands boasts the legendary Highland Bowl, and serves up 135kms of trails - 23% Intermediate, 12% Advanced, 65% Expert (no beginner runs here). Snowmass offers the largest acreage and diversity by having something for everyone, offering 241kms of trails – 5% Beginner, 48% Intermediate, 17% Advanced, 30% Expert. And Buttermilk Mountain, home of the Aspen X Games, is a kids' and beginners' paradise, with 34kms of trails – 35% Beginner, 39% Intermediate, 21% Advanced, 5% Expert.

Aspen's beautiful scenery and open space also lends itself well to other types of winter recreation, such as cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. After a hard day of play enjoy Aspen's legendary après ski scene, or head out for dinner at one of their world-class restaurants

Accommodation

The Gant is Aspen Colorado's premier condominium resort; providing the comforts of home with the services of a fine hotel, all within a world-class destination. - Single Room will be Triple Occupancy (your own room, sharing a 2 bedroom condo): Add \$940.
- Land Only: Deduct \$500. The transfer bus will not wait for passengers who are arranging their own air travel. No discount will be given for missed transfers and those passengers must make their own arrangements to get to the resort.

Aspen Snowmass 4 mountain area offers 336 runs. Stats:

- 6% beginner (green circle)
- 43% intermediate (blue square)
- 17% advanced (black diamond)
- 34% expert (double-black diamond)
- Longest run 7 kms
- 42 lifts including 6 cable cars/gondolas, 30 chairlifts, and 6 surface lifts

Passport / Travel Documents

Canadian citizens need a Canadian passport that is valid until at least 6 months after the scheduled return date. Other nationalities may require different documents. It is necessary for such people to advise their nationality at the time of booking so that we can determine what travel documents they will require in order to participate in this trip. For all





nationalities, please note that entry to another country may be refused even if the required information and travel documents are complete.

Note: Members are solely responsible to ensure that their travel documents are complete, valid and in order.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Policies are set by the Tour Operators, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.

- Deposits and Insurance Premium are non-refundable.
- Single Supplement charge is non-refundable unless a substitute is found.
- From November 25 to departure, total holiday cost is non-refundable.

Optional Travel Insurance

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is available to protect non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. All Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person, contact Tour Operator in advance for a quote. To get the proper quote you must specify your name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost.

Insurance is non-refundable from date of issuance. Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above. Passengers must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above dates.

Tickets are 100% non-refundable once issued. Name changes and deviations are not permitted once ticketed. Individuals must ensure that all names are spelled correctly and match their personal identification on their passport. The Tour Operator and Airline will not be held liable for delays or cancellations caused by strikes, labour disputes, government actions, weather or any cause beyond the Tour Operator's or Airline's control. The Airline reserves the right to change equipment or schedules. The customer hereby releases and waives any claims against the Airline and Tour Operator regarding cancellation or schedule changes.
