



W4 Orford-Sutton, Family Day Weekend

Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

This is a 3 day skiing and snowboarding trip in Québec's beautiful Eastern Townships, the first day at Sutton and the next two days at Orford.

Sutton is known for the "Best Glade Skiing in the East" and has a reputation for great snow. Mont Orford, with 3 peaks and its hybrid 6-pack/gondola lift makes for a great ski experience.

Relatively close (6.5 hours by Google), we are staying at the luxurious Manoir des Sables where we will enjoy breakfast and dinner. The hotel has an indoor swimming pool, hot tub and exercise room along with high-end spa facilities with Finnish sauna and Nordic baths. You may choose to skate at the on-site rink at our hotel or explore the skating path around the lake in Magog.

Manoir des Sables is located 5 km east of Mont Orford and 5 km north of the quaint little town of Magog on Lake Memphrémagog. Join HPSC instructors each day for guided skiing, as available, and get some valuable tips. Breakfasts and dinners are included in the overall price.

Lift Tickets

3 day lift tickets are included (Orford, Sutton, Orford).

Option for Sat-Sun lift tickets (Orford, Sutton).

Tickets are not interchangeable: Day 1 - Sat at Orford, Day 2 - Sun at Sutton, Day 3 - Mon at Orford.

Meals

3 full hot/cold breakfast buffet each morning to get your ski day started.

2 buffet dinners; 2 drink tickets (wine, beer, soda) – to be used at après ski or at either dinner.

Departure

On Friday 18, 2022 from Yonge & York Mills, Toronto at 2:00 pm and 2:30 pm from Scarborough.

On Monday February 21, 2022 from the hotel at 4:00pm.

Transportation

To the ski area and return will be by HPSC premium charter coach.

What you should know and fine print

Resort

Located in the heart of the beautiful Eastern Townships, Manoir des Sables offers hotel rooms with an exceptional view of their private lake (Lake Écluse) or Mont Orford. The Manoir has its own x-country and snowshoe trails with rentals available on site along with ice-skating on Lake Écluse if you wish to indulge in other winter snow options. Our HPSC premium charter coach will take us to Mont Orford on Saturday (less than 10 minutes), to Mont Sutton (approx an hour drive) on Sunday. A private shuttle bus will take us to Mont Orford on Monday morning. HPSC bus will pick up skiers and bring to the hotel for the departure home at 4:00 pm. Members may plan a day off skiing to enjoy the spa or explore the town of Magog.

Travel Insurance

For overnight bus trips, members are responsible for arranging their own trip cancellation insurance and medical insurance, and it is **strongly recommended**. Insurance can be purchased from a number of Toronto sources. Some credit cards also provide coverage but check carefully that it will apply to your trip. All insurance claims must be made by the member to their own insurance company.
