



## W8 Mont Ste Anne, Quebec

### Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

Ski-in, ski-out from the foot of the Mont Ste Anne gondola and enjoy your stay at Château Mont Sainte Anne. Get on the hills as early or as late as you wish; no bus, no shuttle, maximize your skiing and your relaxing time. Try a couple of top to bottom runs if your legs can handle it. Mont-Sainte-Anne is renowned for its impeccable snow conditions, grooming and expert area.

The skiable terrain includes 71 trails covering 73 kilometres spread across 3 sides of the mountain. After sundown, 19 trails remain floodlit for night skiing. The skiing terrain offers breathtaking scenery all around the mountain, with the St. Lawrence River, Ile d'Orléans and the Laurentians. Mont-Sainte-Anne and has one of the largest snowmaking systems in the East. Lifts include 1 high speed 8 person gondola, 4 quad chairlifts (3 high speed, 1 has bubble covers) and 4 surface lifts.

There will be an optional excursion into Quebec City one evening to see old Quebec and experience some French cuisine at a restaurant of your choice in the old town. Meal cost is not included. After the first day skiing there will be a 10 minute drive down the mountain to stores in Beaufort if you wish to shop for breakfast supplies, snacks and refreshments.

We are not organized a X-country program on this trip but those interested could make their own way to nearby Mont-Sainte-Anne Cross-country Ski Center. It offers the largest X-country area in Canada. It is nestled in the beautiful scenery of the Laurentian forest and features 200 km of trails, including a 191 km network for skate skiing. It is located only 7 km from the downhill area, where skiers have direct access to the cross-country network. If you're looking for something other than downhill or cross country skiing, consider snowshoeing – the area boasts 37 km of snowshoeing trails accessible at the ski resort. Dog sledding is also available for an additional charge.

While the date of this trip is late March, there is always tons of snow at Mt Ste Anne at this time of year. The sun will be high in the sky after DST time change so suntan lotion is important. And consider a lighter jacket for spring conditions... but it can be quite cold too.

## What's included

### Accommodation

#### Chateau Mont Ste Anne: double occupancy hotel room

Hotel rooms will have 2 persons to each room. This hotel is true ski in ski out. Just walk to the end of the hall and step out to the gondola base. All rooms have a basic kitchenette with dishes, microwave oven, mini-fridge, and coffee-maker. Some have a cooktop. As a guest at Château Mont Sainte Anne, you will have access to outdoor hot tubs at the foot of the mountain, an indoor swimming pool, sauna, spa, fitness room and a mini-cinema. The Château Mont Sainte Anne restaurant Bistro Nordik features Nordic inspired cuisine which showcases the best that nature has to offer in all its diversity, particularly products from the Côte-de-Beaupré and surrounding area.

### Lift Tickets

4-day lift tickets are included. (Senior is 65+).

### Meals

No breakfast is included. Bring your own supplies for your kitchenette. Options to purchase breakfast will be explained closer to departure. You can also pick up supplies at the grocery store after the first ski day. Lunches and dinners at your own cost.

### Departure

On Sunday, March 20, 2022 from Yonge & York Mills, Toronto at 9:00 am and 9:30 am from Scarborough  
On Thursday, March 24, 2022 from Mont Ste Anne at 2.30 pm.

### Transportation

To Mont Ste Anne and return will be by HPSC premium charter coach.
