### Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

Enjoy one of North America's Top 10 verticals, a brilliant climate, and Canada's largest outdoor on-hill hot pool. Ski or ride the 2,975 acres of terrain, ranging from wide-open fall-line cruisers to powder-filled tree lines and the steep and deep exhilaration of Taynton Bowl. Great skiing for the week plus the opportunity to try heli-skiing if that interests you. [RK Heliski](#) centre is located in the Panorama Village. Or try out Toby Creek Snowmobile tours. Panorama Nordic Centre is 200 m from the resort with an extensive set of X-country trails. (For 2022, the optional day trip to [Kicking Horse](#) Mountain resort is TBD).

### What does it cost

**\$1,710** per person, (VISA/MC/Amex)

4 per 2-bdrm condo, for 3 in a condo, one member will add the single room option **\$520**.

**\$1,900** per person, 2 per 1-bdrm condo, or **\$2,615** for a single room option.

1-bdrm condo has either 1 king or 1 split king.

Based on Group Pricing - Minimum of 26 participants; price is subject to change for groups less than 26.

- ❄ Deposit: \$100 online registration deposit.
- ❄ Booking Deposit: \$500 to Tour Operator+ insurance if taken, due at time of booking.
- ❄ Final Balance due: December 1, 2021
- ❄ Booking Deadline: December 1, 2021 (after this time, un-booked space will be released).

**Note:** all deposits, insurance premiums and administrative fees are NON-refundable. If this trip is cancelled by HPSC or the tour operator before December 1, 2021, all deposits will be refunded in full, but **NOT** the insurance premiums.

## What's included

### Accommodation

Panorama Springs Lodge OR Taynton Lodge: ([details follow](#))

7 nights, 2 bedroom, 2 bathroom condominium units. Based upon quad occupancy, these condos feature fully equipped kitchens, dining room, living room & balcony. Two bedroom units have 2 Split Kings or a Queen and 1 Split King in each bedroom. You will have access to the Pine Inn fitness centre and complimentary high speed wireless internet at either location. The lodges are located beside each other and offer true ski-in ski-out access to the mountain.

### Meals

No meals are included. You may use the cooking facilities in the condo or choose any of the restaurants within a 5 minute walk. There will be a grocery stop enroute to Panorama from the airport where you can buy groceries and liquid refreshments. This is highly recommended if you will be cooking during the week. While there is a store in Panorama village, it is small with limited choices.

### Lift Tickets

5 out of 6 day Adult lift pass included in trip price

- ❄ 6 Day Adult lift ticket: Add \$95 to the Adult 5 day price
- ❄ 5 Day Senior (65+): Deduct \$40 from the Adult 5 day price
- ❄ Senior 6 Day: Add \$35 to the Adult 5 day price
- ❄ No Lifts: deduct \$350
- ❄ Complimentary daily guided tours are available from the Mountain Hosts

### Other Options

- ❄ Own room sharing a 2 bedroom condo, add \$520.
- ❄ Land Only: Deduct \$325. The transfer bus will not wait for passengers who are arranging their own air travel. No discount will be given for missed transfers and those passengers must make their own arrangements to get to the resort.

## Baggage Fees: (subject to change)

- \* 1<sup>st</sup> bag is free up to 23 kg for the group (per direction, including taxes). Those booked separately from the group will pay \$30 + HST for the 1<sup>st</sup> bag (per direction, including taxes).
- \* 2<sup>nd</sup> bag \$50 + HST (per direction, including taxes).

Air Canada considers skis and boots as 1 piece even if in separate bags as long as nothing else is in the bags. (Subject to change, check with the airline.)

## Deviation charges:

Any person deviating from the group itinerary for the return flight only will be charged \$75 CAD plus tax and any additional charges imposed by the suppliers and airlines and are subject to change. Deviations are strictly on a request basis. Members must abide by the prearranged transfer dates and times or arrange their own transfers at their own cost. ## What you should know and fine print

### Resort Info

Panorama is situated in BC's Purcell Mountains, with alpine views to the Rocky Mountains. It offers massive acres of terrain, an intimate village with all the amenities, Canada's largest slopeside hot pools (it's a big deal!) and a huge range of activities. There's nearly 3,000 acres of skiable terrain across 4,265 vertical feet of fall line perfection. The ski area is perfect for many skiers as 50% of the runs are suitable for beginners or intermediates. Think wide open groomers, winding down the fall-line from the summit right to the village base area or to the door of your condo. For black and double black-diamond runs, head to powder heaven that is Taynton Bowl. Formerly a heli-skiing area, Taynton Bowl is now within bounds, so the slopes are patrolled, avalanche controlled and no backcountry gear is needed. Warm up first as the 750 acre bowl is solid black! It's a great place to find powder stashes days after a storm.

- ❄ Alto Kitchen and Bar, Cliffhanger Restaurant, T-Bar & Grill, Jackpine Pub, Fireside Café, The Great Hall, Cabin Resto, Summit Hut, Picnic Café, Thunderbird Pizza, Choppers Landing and of course, halfway up the mountain, Elkhorn Cabin.

### **Passport / Travel Documents**

Canadian Citizens: Travelling within Canada – PHOTO ID is a requirement to board all aircraft.

Note: Members are solely responsible to ensure that their travel documents are sufficient, valid and in order.

### **Cancellation Policy**

*Cancellation Policies are set by the Tour Operators, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.*

- ❄ Your deposits (\$100 + \$500) and any Insurance Premium paid are non-refundable.
- ❄ From December 1, 2021 to departure, 100% of holiday cost is non-refundable.
- ❄ Single Supplement charge is non-refundable unless a substitute is found.
- ❄ All paid for deviation or change administration fees are non-refundable.
- ❄ Any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded. Passengers must go through insurance, if applicable.

### **Optional Travel Insurance**

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is available to protect non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. 'Cancel for Any Reason' coverage can also be added to a newly purchased policy. The insurance premium is due with the deposit. All Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person, **contact Tour Operator in advance for a quote.** To get the proper quote you must specify your name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost.

Insurance is non-refundable from date of issuance. Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above. **Passengers must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above date.**

**A CFAR (Cancel For Any Reason) Insurance Rider may be added to your insurance coverage for an additional premium of 25%.**

### **The Fine Print**

- Trip cost is 100% non-refundable after December 1, 2021.





- Name changes before ticketing may be available for a \$75 fee. Individuals must ensure that all names are spelled correctly and match their personal identification on their passport.
- Name changes after ticketing may be available for a \$175 fee.
- Deviations may be permitted before December 1, 2021 for a fee of \$75 + tax.
- The Tour Operator and Airline will not be held liable for delays or cancellations caused by strikes, labour disputes, government actions, weather or any cause beyond the Tour Operator's or Airline's control. The Airline reserves the right to change equipment or schedules. The customer hereby releases and waives any claims against the Airline and Tour Operator regarding cancellation or schedule changes.

All applicable fuel surcharges and taxes in effect as of August 2021 have been included in the package price. However, in these volatile times the tour operator reserves the right to charge for unanticipated increases in the cost of fuel and taxes as may be imposed by the resort or airline.

Overlooking the renowned Panorama Springs Pools, these popular condos (apartments) offer great location and access to the Mile 1 Express. Walk down a few steps to the Cappuccino Bar at Mountain Outfitters for morning coffee and just a bit further to the heart of the village. The units are well equipped with a fully equipped kitchen (including a dishwasher, fridge, stove and microwave).





**Taynton Lodge:** Overlooking the Silver Platter, these units offer well located, comfortable accommodation. Taynton Lodge has its own hot tubs but also offers free access to the Panorama Springs Pools. Village shopping, dining and Après are less than a 2-minute walk from the front door. The units are well equipped with a fully equipped kitchen (including a dishwasher, fridge, stove and microwave).
