



## C4 Sun Peaks, BC

### Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

This is a HPSC perennial favorite! Sun Peaks is Canada's second largest ski resort with 4270 acres of skiable terrain across three peaks, Mount Tod, Mount Morrissey and Sundance. The resort has 138 runs with 19 glades areas, at an elevation of 2,152 m.

Located in the BC interior, Sun Peaks offers dry snow and fluffy powder with picturesque surroundings. It is a quaint small purpose-built ski town and the friendly village is traffic-free. There are many great restaurants plus a not-to-be-missed mid-mountain Alpine fondue dinner (not included) with night-time ski or snowboard descent.

It offers plenty for skiers of all abilities to enjoy. Mount Tod has some dramatically steep terrain for advanced skiers, while intermediates are well catered for across all 3 mountains with some easy, groomed glades on Mount Morrissey.

At Sun Peaks, you'll enjoy complimentary daily mountain tours, and if you are lucky, you may even get to ski with Nancy Greene who is hosting mountain tours from time to time. In addition to the Alpine Fondue & Starlight Descent, Sun Peaks also offers other winter activities (at additional charge) such as Cat Trax Groomer Rides, Dog Sled Rides and more.

You can choose to stay at the Sun Peaks Lodge, or, for an extra cost, at the Sun Peaks Grand Hotel (first come first serve basis).

## What's included

### Accommodations

- **Sun Peaks Lodge** – [www.sunpeakslodge.com](http://www.sunpeakslodge.com) – A family hotel located in the heart of Sun Peaks, just steps from the chairlift. You can ski from the front door to the chairlift. The comfortable rooms feature a flat screen TV, a king (if available) or 2 queen beds with duvets, mini fridge, private safe, coffee maker, iron/ironing board and hairdryer. Hotel amenities include a hot tub, sauna and steam room (these may be closed due to Covid-19). Free wireless Internet and an Internet station in the lobby, next to the fireplace. The Lodge is home to Sun Peaks Steakhouse Restaurant & Bar and McSporties Ski rental shop.
- **Sun Peaks Grand Hotel** – [www.sunpeaksgrand.com](http://www.sunpeaksgrand.com) – *10 rooms available at an extra cost* (first come first serve). This 4-star property has a convenient location in the village and offers ski in/ski out. Guests can enjoy a health club with an indoor entrance to a heated outdoor pool, 3 hot tubs, well equipped gym, steam room and sauna (amenities may be closed due to Covid-19). The Grand Hotel is home to Mantles Restaurant and Lounge, Night Club & Pub, and offers room service, ski valet and Business Centre. The Deluxe Queen rooms have a hair dryer, mini fridge, free wifi, coffee maker, kettle, iron & ironing board.

- \* Daily hot breakfast buffet (gratuity is included)

### Lift Tickets -

5 day lift pass at Sun Peaks Ski Resort

- \* Senior 5 Day (age 65 and older): Deduct \$75
- \* Senior 6 Day (age 65 and older): Deduct \$15 (from regular package price)
- \* Adult 6 Day: Add \$80
- \* No Lifts: Deduct \$365

### Other Options

- \* Single room: *Sun Peaks Lodge*, add: \$535 - *Sun Peaks Grand Hotel*, add: \$840
- \* Land Only: Deduct \$530. The transfer bus will not wait for passengers who are arranging their own air travel. No discount will be given for missed transfers and those passengers must make their own arrangements to get to the resort.

## Baggage Fees: (subject to change)

- ❄ 1<sup>st</sup> bag is free up to 23 kg for the group (per direction, including taxes). Those booked separately from the group will pay \$30 + HST for the 1<sup>st</sup> bag (per direction, including taxes).
- ❄ 2<sup>nd</sup> bag \$50 + HST (per direction, including taxes).

Air Canada considers skis and boots as 1 piece even if in separate bags as long as nothing else is in the bags. (Subject to change, check with the airline.)

Deviation charges: Any person deviating from the group itinerary will be charged \$50 CAD plus tax and any additional charges imposed by the suppliers and airlines. Deviations are on a request basis. Members must abide by the prearranged transfer dates and times or arrange their own transfers at their own cost.

### Resort Info

Sun Peaks offers 138 trails including 19 glades areas. Stats:

- 10% novice (green circle)
- 58% intermediate (blue square)
- 32% advanced and expert (black diamond and double-black diamond)
- 2 alpine bowls
- Longest run 8 km
- 13 lifts including 3 high speed quad chairlifts, 4 quad chairlifts, and 6 surface lifts
- On average over 2,000 hours of sunshine per year!

## Passport / Travel Documents

Canadian Citizens: Travelling within Canada – PHOTO ID is a requirement to board all aircraft.

**Note:** Members are solely responsible to ensure that their travel documents are complete, valid and in order.

Please consult the Air Canada website at least 2 weeks in advance of the trip for any COVID related regulations that may be in place to be able to board the flight.

**COVID regulations can change at any time and compliance with them is the responsibility of each member. Members should be cognizant of COVID related regulations as they may be advised in the provincial, federal, Air Canada and resort websites at all times, and particularly in the days/weeks just prior to departure.**

## Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Policies are set by the Tour Operators, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.

- ❄ The Deposits and Insurance Premium are non-refundable.
- ❄ Single Supplement cost has to be covered.
- ❄ From 44 to 33 days prior to departure, \$800 per person
- ❄ From 32 days to departure, total holiday cost.
- ❄ Any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded; passengers must go through insurance, if applicable.





## Travel Insurance

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is available to protect non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. 'Cancel for Any Reason' coverage can also be added to a newly purchased policy. The premium is due with the deposit to the tour operator. Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person. **To get the proper quote you must specify your name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost.** After you have registered, paid the \$100 non-refundable deposit and completed Stage-2 of the registration procedure, you will contact the Tour Operator for a quote.

Insurance is non-refundable from date of issuance. Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above. Passengers must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above dates.

**A CFAR (Cancel For Any Reason) Insurance Rider may be added to your insurance coverage for an additional premium of 25%.**

## The Fine Print

Tickets are 100% non-refundable once issued. Name changes and deviations are not permitted once ticketed. Individuals must ensure that all names are spelled correctly and match their personal identification on their passport. The Tour Operator and Airline will not be held liable for delays or cancellations caused by strikes, labour disputes, government actions, weather or any cause beyond the Tour Operator's or Airline's control. The Airline reserves the right to change equipment or schedules. The customer hereby releases and waives any claims against the Airline and Tour Operator regarding cancellation or schedule changes.

All applicable fuel surcharges and taxes in effect as of August have been included in the package price. However in these volatile times the tour operator reserves the right to charge for unanticipated increases in the cost of fuel and taxes imposed by the resort or airline.
