Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

Jackson Hole Mountain Resort is frequently rated tops in North America by the major ski magazines and other pundits, and it combines world class terrain with gorgeous natural scenery and the wonderful Western town of Jackson. Jackson Hole is known as a "skier's mountain," meaning it is hardcore and legendary for its extreme beyond-expert terrain - with its jump-in chute entry that "softens" to a 40-degree "average" pitch, Corbet's Couloir is the most infamous expert trail in the country. That part of the resort hasn't softened, and the Big One still dishes out all the skiing and riding you can handle, but the rest of the resort experience has become much more well-rounded and multi-dimensional, on and off the slopes. The mountain itself has aggressively added more intermediate terrain, grooming and better lifts, and while overshadowed by its fierce steeps and chutes, it has always been a great place to learn to ski or ride. We will be staying at the recently renovated "49er" a 20 minute shuttle bus ride away. Jackson also has a unique slate of non-skiing or alternative skiing activities, thanks in large part to the fact that it is surrounded by both Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks. This offers an array of tours by sno-coach, snowshoe, snowmobile, cross country or backcountry skiing, plus ice climbing, sleigh rides in the National Elk Refuge, museums, cat-skiing, heli-skiing and much more. At the same time, you can't throw a rock around these parts without hitting a first-rate luxury spa. Whether you are skiing hard or hardly skiing, chances are you will love Jackson Hole!

- ❄ No Lifts: including IKON Base Plus Pass, deduct \$1,125
- ❄ IKON pass holders must purchase their own 6th day lift ticket at the ski resort

IMPORTANT: In 2023, Jackson Hole Ski Resort will limit the number of skiers & boarders each day, so lift tickets will be purchased at the time of deposit thus the deposit includes a lift ticket component. Those with an IKON or IKON Base Pass Plus card are required to make their own advance reservations with the resort for lift access during our week. The tour operator cannot do this for you.

While in Jackson Hole, you may want to ski for one day at nearby Grand Targhee resort which is renowned for its great powder days. This is not included in the price of the trip. If you are considering a day at Grand Targhee, you would purchase the 5 day lift option and not the 6 day lift option. Lift tickets and transportation to Grand Targhee are an extra cost which is not included in the price of the trip.

Other Options

- ❄ Single room, add \$515 (limited availability)
- ❄ Land Only (no air), deduct \$700. The transfer bus will not wait for passengers who are arranging their own air travel. No discount will be given for missed transfers and those passengers must make their own arrangements to get to the resort.
- ❄ Free ski shuttles to Jackson Hole Mountain Resort
- ❄ Complimentary daily guided tours
- ❄ The optional day trip to Grand Targhee resort is planned for one of, or both, Jan 24 and 25. The resort, roughly one hour shuttle from Jackson, has installed a new lift opening this season to access terrain that was previously only accessible for cat skiing. Please contact the trip leader for more details.

Resort Info

Jackson Hole, Wyoming, is an historic cowboy town famous for its cowboy bars. Our hotel is located within walking distance of the old town square giving easy access to the night life. The ski hill is known for having the largest vertical in the US which gives it a combination of some world famous difficult runs mixed with excellent mogul and intermediate runs. The geography separates the difficult runs from the extensive intermediate and beginner terrain allowing all levels of skier to find areas in which they are comfortable.

Passport / Travel Documents

Canadian citizens need a Canadian passport that is valid until at least 6 months after the scheduled return date. Other nationalities may require different documents. It is necessary for such people to advise their nationality at the time of booking so that we can determine what travel documents they will require in order to participate in this trip. For all nationalities, please note that entry to another country may be refused even if the required information and travel documents are complete.

Note: Members are solely responsible to ensure that their travel documents are complete, valid and in order.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Policies are set by the Tour Operators, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.

- ❄ All Deposits and Insurance Premiums are non-refundable.
- ❄ Single room option cost must be covered. (If you cancel from the single room option, another single must be found to replace your room otherwise the single supplement is not refundable.)
- ❄ From November 16, 2022 to departure, total holiday cost is non-refundable.
- ❄ Any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded; passengers must go through insurance, if applicable.

Optional Travel Insurance

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is available to protect non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. "Cancel for Any Reason" coverage can be added to a newly purchased policy. The premium is due with the deposit to the tour operator. Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person.

To get the proper quote you must specify your name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost. After you have registered, paid the \$100 non-refundable deposit and completed Stage-2 of the registration procedure, you will contact the Tour Operator for a quote.

Merit Travel offers trip cancellation insurance with Allianz Global Assist and a "Cancel For Any Reason" rider can be added for an additional 25% supplement. This allows cancellation for any reason up to 7 days prior to receive a refund of 75% of the prepaid travel arrangements, and from 6 days to 48 hours prior for a refund of 75% up to a maximum of \$1,500.00, and within 48 hours the cancellation must be for medical reasons only for any refund. When "cancel for any reason" rider is purchased, it will protect the entire cost of the package and must be purchased at the time of deposit.

Insurance is non-refundable from date of issuance. Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above. Passengers must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above dates.





The Fine Print

Tickets are 100% non-refundable once issued. Name changes and deviations are not permitted once ticketed. Individuals must ensure that all names are spelled correctly and match their personal identification on their passport. The Tour Operator and Airline will not be held liable for delays or cancellations caused by strikes, labor disputes, government actions, weather or any cause beyond the Tour Operator's or Airline's control. The Airline reserves the right to change equipment or schedules. The customer hereby releases and waives any claims against the Airline and Tour Operator regarding cancellation or schedule changes.

All applicable fuel surcharges and taxes in effect as of August have been included in the package price. However in these volatile times the tour operator reserves the right to charge for unanticipated increases in the cost of fuel and taxes imposed by the resort or airline.
