



## HPSC Cross-Country Ski/Snowshoe Daytrips Demystified

1. Get to your bus stop and introduce yourself to the other skiers.
2. The bus arrives. Stow your skis below the bus and get on the bus with your bag and ski boots.
3. Choose a seat. Don't be shy! You will sit in the same seat on the way back.
4. Once all skiers are on the bus and we are on the highway, the bus captain will make announcements about the day.
5. The bus captain will then come around and check off your name and collect any money that might be owed (always ensure you come with cash!).
6. The ski school director will come around and confirm lessons. Don't worry if you didn't sign up for a lesson online, you can add yourself to one on the bus.
7. Upon arrival, the renters get off with the instructors and go get their equipment. The bus captain goes inside to get the trail passes. Everyone else remains on the bus.
8. The bus captain returns, and everyone gets off the bus, collects their trail pass from the bus captain and equipment from under the bus, and heads to the chalet.
9. Find a place inside to put your things and get ready.
10. Students meet their instructors in front of the chalet approx. 30 mins after arrival. Not taking lessons? Go ski!
11. Lessons and skiing in the morning.
12. After lessons or morning skiing, take a lunch break.
13. Skiing with friends in the afternoon. There may also be a race or another fun activity scheduled.
14. The bus usually leaves at 4:30pm SHARP. Be sure you get back in time to gather your things and get on the bus.
15. Put your equipment in the marked return bin (based on where you are getting off the bus), sit in the same seat you were in on the way up, and enjoy the ride home!
