



## HPSC Cross-Country Ski and Snowshoe Pricing Grid

When you sign up for one of HPSC's cross-country ski/snowshoe day trips, the daytrip cost includes the bus fee, trail fee (ski or snowshoe pass), and the cost of any equipment rentals. These are charged to your credit card when you register.

- ❄ The bus fee for all trips has increased by \$5 as bus costs have significantly increased due to inflation.
- ❄ Destinations that are further away have a higher bus fee.
- ❄ Horseshoe and Hardwood require members to book rentals online on their websites prior to the trip. Hardwood offers a discount code; Horseshoe does not offer group rental rates.
- ❄ If HPSC cancels a trip, the entire cost will be refunded on your credit card.
- ❄ To cancel without penalty, you must cancel before 8pm on the Tuesday before your trip. After this, and you forfeit your bus fee. Hardwood and Horseshoe have said they will refund rentals (Hardwood will take a 10% admin fee).
- ❄ You may receive a bus voucher at some point during the season (e.g., for volunteering). These can be used for regular bus fees. If the bus fee is higher than \$35, you must pay the difference.
